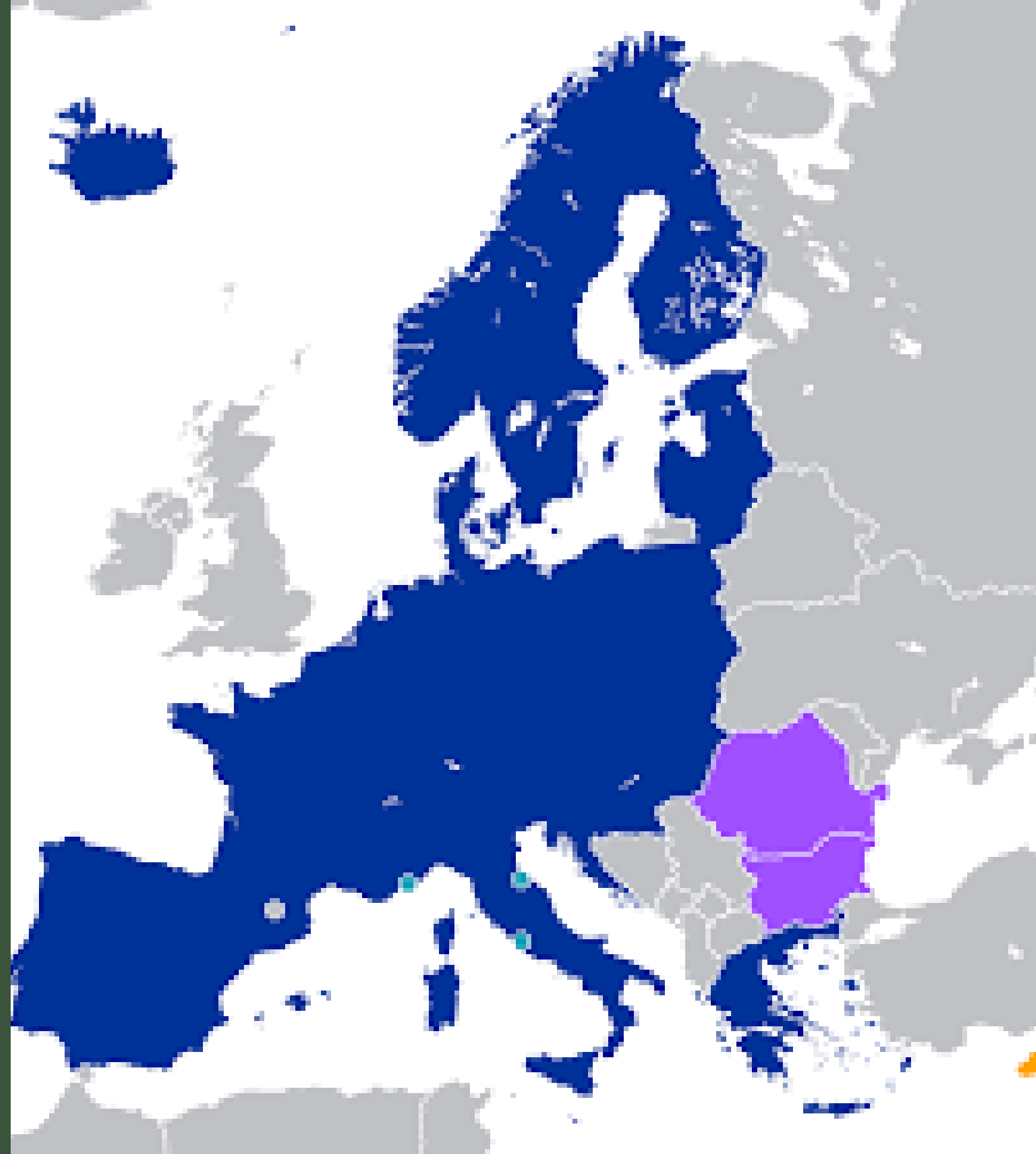


WHAT IS IT?

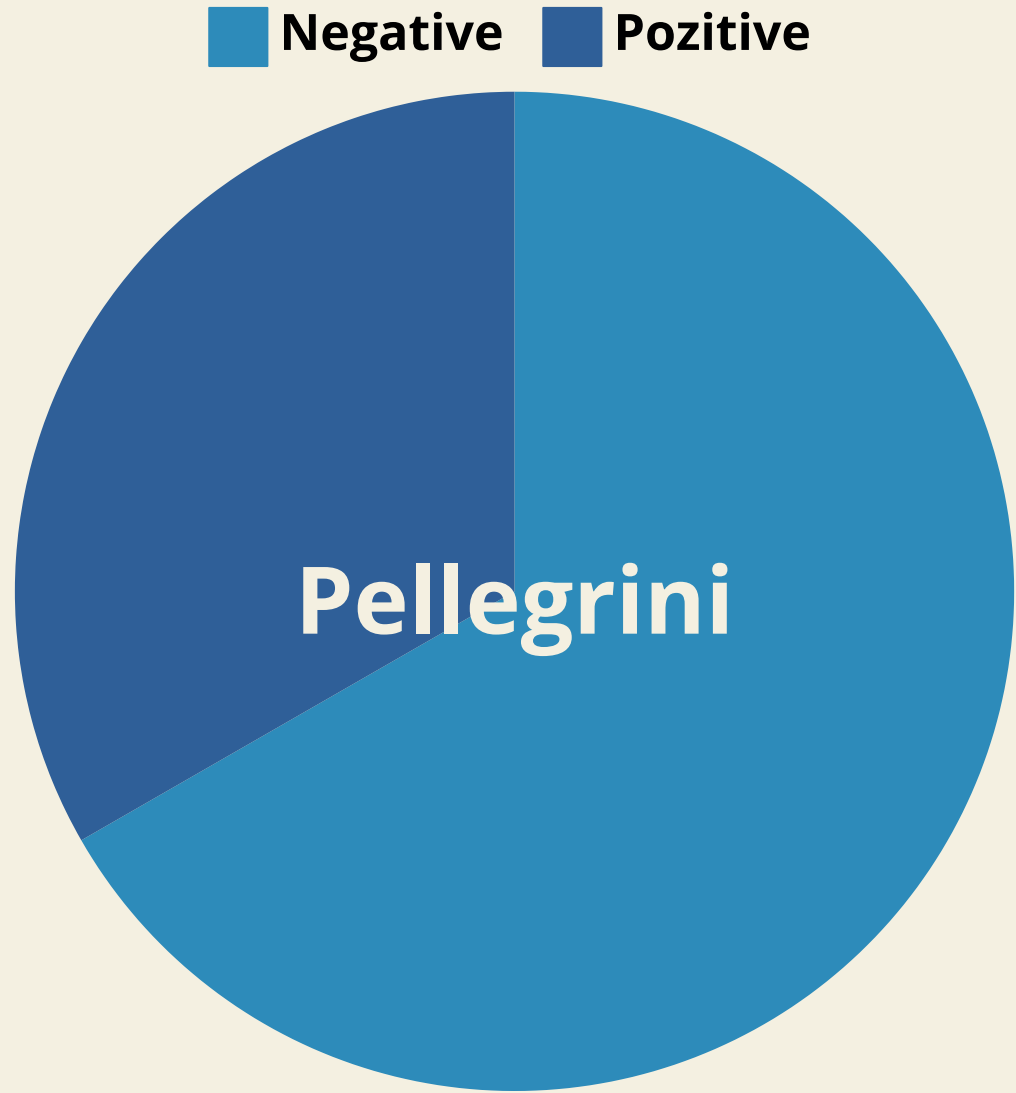
