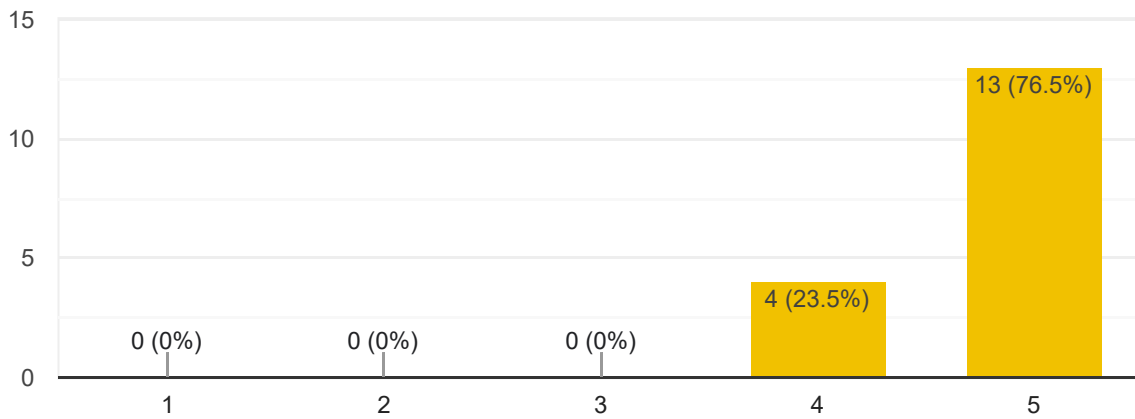

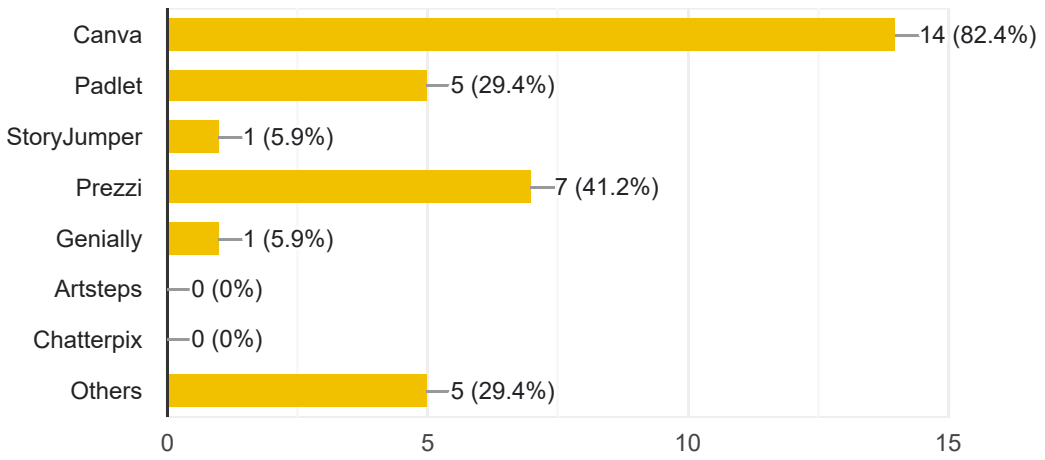

2. What were the digital tools that you liked to use the most? (select only 3)

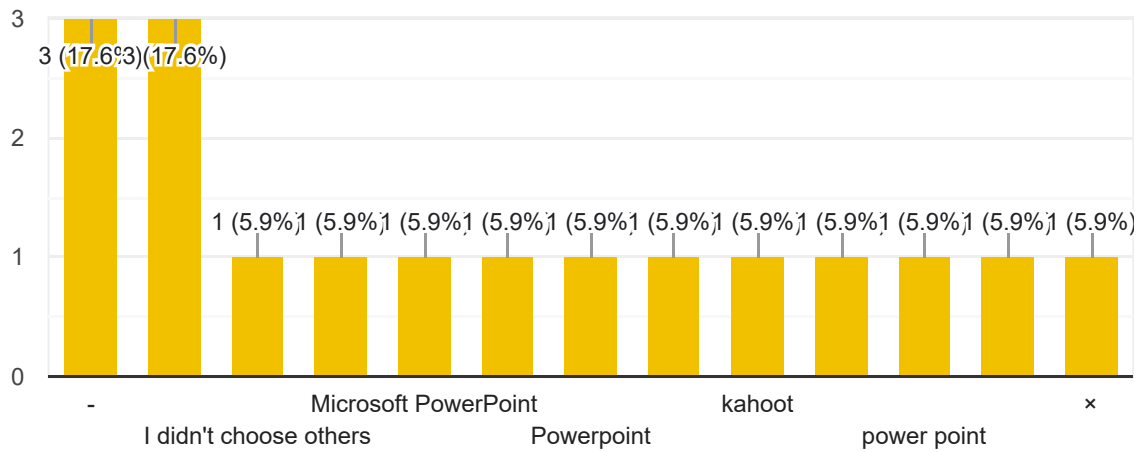

There was no aktivity that I don't like.

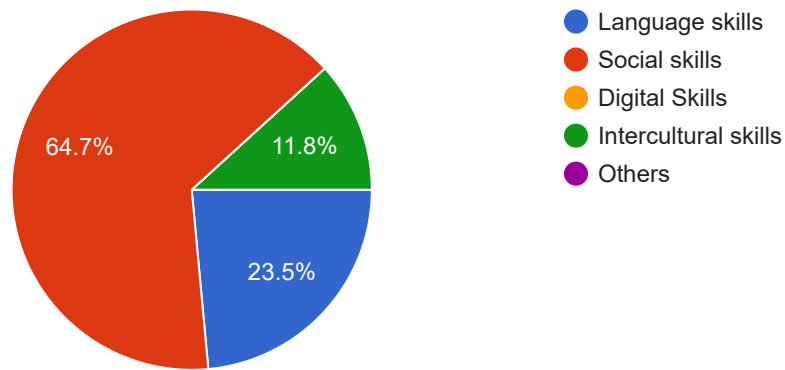

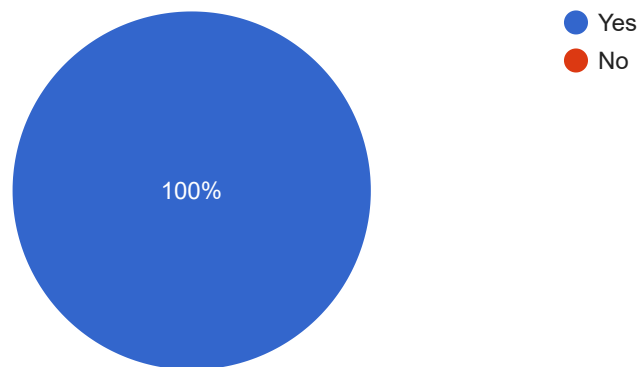

6. Do you feel that participating in this project has improved your learning in the different subjects? (English, History, Geography, ICT, Citizenship and Development...)



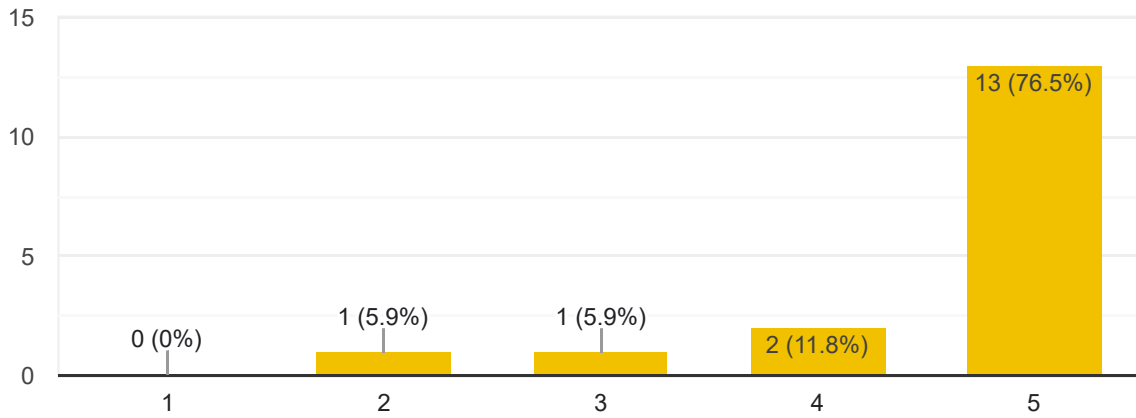
